How to get to Porquerolles



The workshop and summer school will be held at the Centre IGESA, on the Island of Porquerolles, Hyères, France. This is one of a three-island group directly to the South of Hyères, and South East of Marseille (where IRPHE is located).

The Centre IGESA is in the village of the island of Porquerolles, 5 min by foot from the port. It belongs to the armed forces of France as a recreation and meeting location.

By plane

1h30 flight from Paris to local airport : “Toulon / Hyères”.

Then by bus (bus 102 to Hyères bus station + bus 67) or by taxi to ‘La Tour Fondue’ (10 minutes drive)

By train

The closest train station is Hyères.

From the train station, take the bus 67 (time table) to ‘La Tour Fondue’.

By car

Exit the motorway at Hyères, then follow the signs “Les Iles d’Or” – “Porquerolles” – “La Tour Fondue”

Once you’ve reached ‘La Tour Fondue’, regular boats cross over to the Island. (20 minute trip, last boat: 18h30, time table)

IGESA centre is in the village, 5 minute walk from the harbour near “la plage de la courtade”.
