

Selection results for the SCAT Grant-holders

14 November 2008 - Web-based

Introduction

This round of selection is the last one of the current SCAT project, and has been possible thanks to the extension granted in a Contract Addendum dated 23 October 2008.

The extension has been approved based upon figures estimated in July 2008. The budget at that time allowed for 7 new grants and 4 extended scholarships, adding to 68 months of stipend, plus corresponding trips.

Four months later, in late October 2008, a total of 4 extensions where suggested and 6 new applications were received, adding to 61 months of stipend and related trips, being therefore within budget until the end of the project.

The selection procedure has been web-based, and comprised two stages:

- 1. <u>Screening of grant holders</u>, whereby the files are individually checked against the selection criteria in order to ensure suitability and eligibility of all applicants. Only suitable applicants would be submitted for selection, with a screening sheet detailing the essential information of each applicant.
- 2. <u>Selection</u>, which is made online by the SCAT Scholarship Committee. All technical information as well as qualitative documentation regarding the applicants is posted for the Committee to judge the quality of the applicants.

Screening

At this stage, all supervisors and tutors have revised the application dossiers, which in most cases they helped build together with the applicant.

Applications are then sent to the project manager for revision, in order to check administrative compliance and eligibility of the dossier. All received files have been revised against the criteria detailed in the procedure enforced for all applications (*ApplicationProcedure_en_v1-7.pdf*)

Discussion of the dossiers

After careful revision of the files, the project manager concludes that all applicants are eligible. The following are the observations raised during the screening:

1. Jaime Zúñiga (from U-Chile, Santiago)

He would be able to start on 01 March 09 only, due to prior commitments. This would make a 5 months stay, which is acceptable apparently from the tutor and supervisor's point of view.







2. Jocelyn Dunstan (from U-Chile, Santiago)

She is financed for a 6 months' research project at DFI-UChile -including 1 month in France- and she seeks a grant to make a second stay of 3 months in Paris to conclude her project. This is detailed in her abstract and has been agreed between the parties already.

Results of the selection procedure:

For the 4 renewing applicants, selection was granted already in a previous selection procedure. The outcome for the 6 new applications is summarized as follows:

1. Alberto Beltrán : selected

Alberto is granted a SCAT scholarship for an initial period of 8 months at Universitat Politécnica de Catalnuya under the supervision of Manel Soria.

2. Rodrigo Demarco: selected

Rodrigo is granted a SCAT scholarship for an initial period of 8 months at Université Provence Marseille under the supervision of Andres Fuentes.

3. Fernando Aguayo: selected

Fernando is granted a SCAT scholarship for an initial period of 8 months at Université Provence Marseille under the supervision of Jean-Pierre Clerc.

4. Jaime Zúñiga: selected

Jaime is granted a SCAT scholarship for an initial period of 5 months at Ecole Supérieure de Physique et de Chimie Industrielle under the supervision of Agnès Maurel.

5. Jocelyn Dunstan: selected

Jocelyn is granted a SCAT scholarship for an initial period of 4 months at Ecole Supérieure de Physique et de Chimie Industrielle under the supervision of Eric Clément.
